7.	I am aware that the premises to which this Statutory Declaration relates is subject to compliance auditing by Council (Ipswich City Council) under Section 360ZE of the <i>Water Act 2000</i> , with penalties applying for non-compliance.

¹ *Water end use devices*: All taps, shower heads, trigger sprays and urinals on the premises that must be water efficient for compliance with QWC requirements. This includes toilets and all end use devices for the 10+ML/annum users. The *QWC Level 6 Water Restriction Schedule 2* defines the level of water efficiency for each device. Best practice for each end use is required for 10+ML/annum users, which is a more onerous standard.
